



Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) & Points of Dispensing (POD) Training

OVERVIEW:

If an event occurs in which the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) has to be accessed by the State of Alabama, health professionals and others should be familiar with the SNS and how to respond when received. The SNS training course will benefit a variety of health professionals including pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, nurses, social workers, mental health personnel, emergency management personnel, immunization personnel and others.

TRAINING ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

- ◆ Plenary session providing a general overview of the SNS for all participants
- ◆ Demonstration and exercise of a POD site
- ◆ Breakout sessions for each of the disciplines to discuss professional issues, evaluations, awarding of certificates and adjournment. Each breakout session will be led by a professional within that discipline

- ◆ Describe the purpose and goals of Strategic National Stockpile (SNS)
- ◆ List and understand the need for and duties of volunteers
- ◆ Describe the sequence of progression through a POD
- ◆ Describe how the State of Alabama's SNS Plan will contribute to pandemic influenza preparedness
