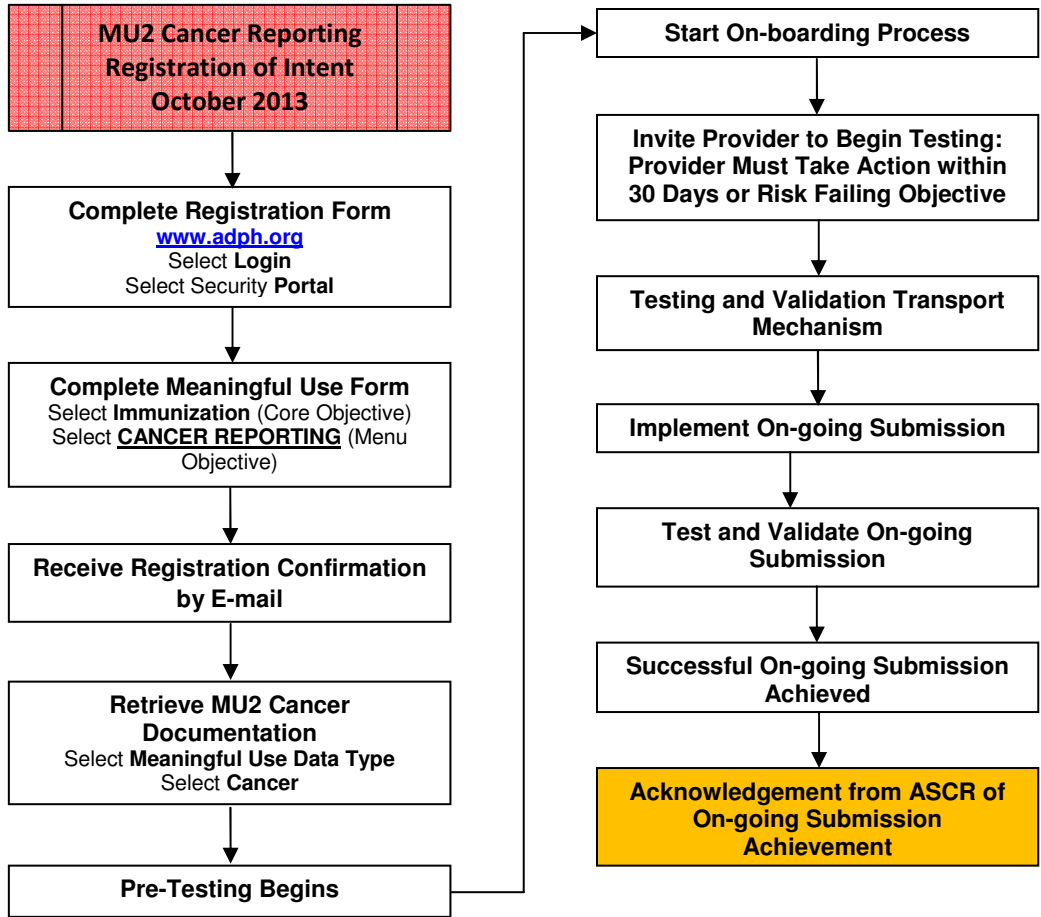


Eligible Professionals*
(EPs that have selected the Cancer Reporting Menu Objective)

- MU2 17 Core Objectives**
- 1) Submit immunization registries electronically
 - 2) Use computerized provider order entry (CPOE)
 - 3) Generate/transmit permissible prescriptions electronically (eRx)
 - 4) Record patient demographic information
 - 5) Record/chart vital signs
 - 6) Record smoking status
 - 7) Use clinical decision support
 - 8) Provide patients the ability to access their health information online
 - 9) Provide clinical summaries
 - 10) Protect health information
 - 11) Incorporate clinical lab-test results electronically
 - 12) Generate lists of patients
 - 13) Send patients reminders of preventive/follow-up care
 - 14) Identify patient-specific education resources
 - 15) Perform medication reconciliation
 - 16) Provide patient summary of care record to referring physicians
 - 17) Use secure messaging

- MU2 6 Menu Objectives****
- 1) Implement Electronic Cancer Reporting
 - 2) Submit electronic syndromic surveillance data
 - 3) Record electronic notes
 - 4) Submit imaging results
 - 5) Record patient family health history
 - 6) Implement electronic reporting to specialized registries (other than cancer registry)



* Eligible Professionals (EPs) can participate in electronic cancer reporting after EPs have met the requirements of Meaningful Use Stage 1 (MU1). HL7 Clinical Document Architecture (CDA) electronic data transmission is required for electronic cancer reporting.
