

Third time's the charm!



It takes three doses of the HPV vaccine to be fully protected.

- HPV causes cervical cancer and many other cancers in men and women.
- The HPV vaccine is recommended for males and females age 9-26 to prevent cancers and diseases later in life.
- The ADPH encourages you to pair the first dose of the HPV vaccine with the required 6th grade vaccinations (TDAP/Meningococcal)
- The vaccine is available at ALL County Health Departments at little or no cost to children ages 9 to 18.
- Dependents up to age 26 may be covered by their parents' insurance.
