Learn the facts and dispel the myths associated with this growing problem in our area.

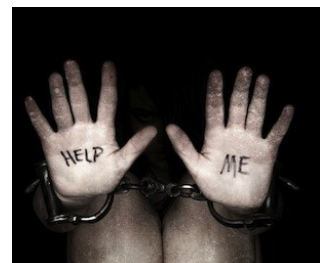
