### **Directions to Sheraton Birmingham Hotel:** **FROM I-65 OR WEST I-20/I-59**

I-65 will merge onto I-20/I-59 East. Take first exit after the merge, which is 17<sup>th</sup> Street Exit. At first light take a left onto 8<sup>th</sup> Ave North. Go to 21<sup>st</sup> Street and make a left (21<sup>st</sup> Street is also Richard Arrington, Jr. Blvd North). You will go under Interstate 20/59 and you will see the BJCC and Hotel immediately ahead of you. To reach the BJCC/Medical Forum Parking Deck: Continue past the BJCC & Hotel, at the 1<sup>st</sup> red light take a right onto 22nd Street, one way, and the Medical Forum is directly ahead of you on the right with the BJCC parking deck on your left.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM I-20 EAST**

As you approach downtown, you will exit to the LEFT on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Street exit. Go straight to the light, which is 21<sup>st</sup> Street, take a right (21<sup>st</sup> Street is also Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd. North). The BJCC & Hotel are directly ahead of you. To reach the BJCC/Medical Forum Parking Deck: Continue past the BJCC & Hotel, at the 1<sup>st</sup> red light take a right onto 22nd Street, one way, and the Medical Forum is directly ahead of you on the right with the BJCC parking deck on your left.
