

## BREASTFEEDING EDUCATOR COURSE





September 8-9, 2016 8a-4p Grandview Medical Center Birmingham, Alabama (Lunch on your own) This <u>free</u> breastfeeding educator class is being offered to nursing staff at delivering hospitals by the Alabama Breastfeeding Committee. The purpose of this class is to increase the knowledge base of L&D, nursery, NICU, and post partum nurses, so that they may effectively assist any mother in making an informed choice regarding how her baby will be fed. They will also learn to provide basic assistance and support to the mother and newborn to initiate breastfeeding, as well as teaching them the importance of exclusive breastfeeding for at least six months.

The Alabama Department of Public Health is an approved provider of continuing nursing education by the Alabama State Nurses Association, an accredited approver of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
