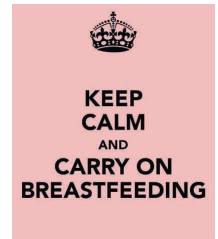




BREASTFEEDING EDUCATOR COURSE



This free breastfeeding educator class is being provided for delivering hospitals throughout the state of Alabama, by the Alabama Breastfeeding Committee. The purpose of this class is to increase the knowledge base of L&D, nursery, NICU, and post partum nurses, so that they may effectively assist any mother in making an informed choice regarding how her baby will be fed and to provide basic assistance to the mother and newborn with initiation of breastfeeding. Participants will also teach mothers how to continue breastfeeding after discharge.

This course meets the required education component of nursing training required by Baby Friendly USA. Skill hours (5) must be obtained through your facility.
