- Understand causes, presentation and initial treatment of hypovolemic shock
- Understand the physical exam for shock and lab test evaluating shock
- Understand recommended tests for sick newborn, risk factor for infection, clinical signs and symptom of infection
- Understand lab test evaluation and potential pharmacological treatments
- Understand crisis families experience when infants require intensive care, ways to support parents of sick infants
